


AM I 10 ACRE EXEMPT FROM PERMITS FOR AN ON-SITE SEPTIC FACILITY?

I have one tract of land 10 acres or more, with only one single family residence and one septic system supplying that home and the field line or sewage disposal line is not closer than 100 feet of the property line. **YES**


This only means, you do not have to purchase a septic permit or submit planning materials to our office. You are still required, by the state to have a site and soil evaluation conducted to determine the type of system that can be installed. You must install that type of system and it must be installed according to the requirements of Chapter 285.



I have one tract of land 10 acres or more, with two or more residence and one septic system, supplying both/all of them. **NO**

I have one tract of land 10 acres or more. There is currently one residence with an existing septic system. I want to build a second residence with its own septic system. **NO**

Only the first system installed qualifies for the 10 acre exemption. The second system must go through the permitting process.



I have two or more tracts of land that equal up to 10 acres or more. **NO**



I have a 20 or 40 acre tract. Does that mean I get an exemption for each ten acres? **NO.**

In regards to permits. Ten acre exemption only applies to the first septic system. It does not exempt a person from development or 911 addressing permits.
